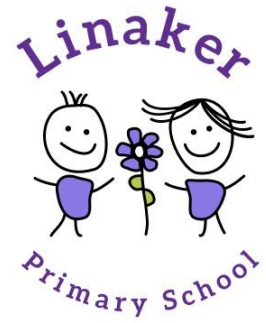

## **British Values and Policy statement**

Linaker Primary School recognises that our children are a part of the wider British Society, which is multi-cultural and multi-faith in its composition.

Linaker Primary School will ask parents for voluntary contributions for:

The school reserves the right to cancel activities / events / trips if voluntary contributions do not cover the cost.

The school will not charge for property damaged accidentally but where it is considered that property / equipment has been damaged maliciously a charge will be made.

The school will ask for a contribution for lost reading books and bags.  
Trips outside the school day and curriculum must be paid for (e.g. theatre trips)

It will be at the Headteacher's discretion if charges are waived due to financial hardship.

### **Snack**

Snack is given daily in the foundation stage and throughout KS1 and school covers the cost of this. Toast is available on a Tuesday at a cost of £1 per half term.

### **Dinner Money**

Reception and KS1 are entitled to a free school meal

The cost to KS2 is:

Full week £12.25

1 day £2.45

Dinner Money should be paid via Schoolmoney.
