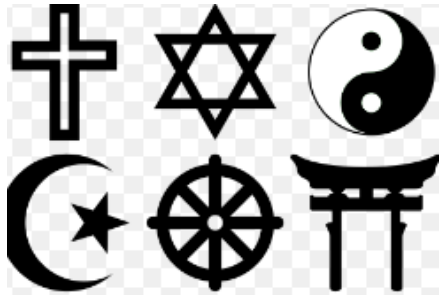

- A faith is a belief in a religion such as Christianity and Judaism.
 - There are different ways we can belong to a community such as going to church, synagogue, going to a wedding or baptism,
 - A synagogue is a sacred place where Jewish people pray and worship God.
 - A church is a sacred place where Christians pray and worship God.
 - Christians and Jewish people believe that there is only one God.
 - The star of David is the symbol of the Jewish faith, and the cross is the symbol for Christianity.
 - Jewish and Christian symbols are different.
 - Baptisms and weddings are two ceremonies that show belonging to a religion.
 - Shabbat is a Jewish celebration to show they belong to Judaism.
