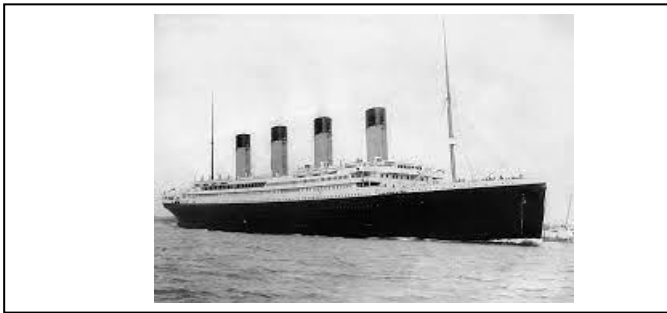

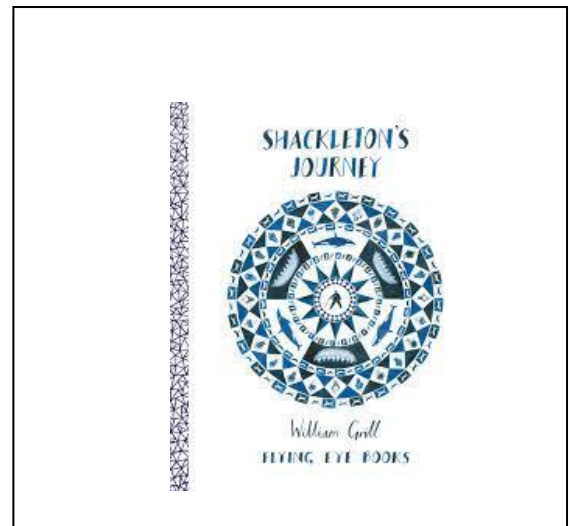


## Books we are reading:
