<b>Israelites</b>	People of the ancient Hebrew nation.	<b>Ten Commandments</b>	The laws for the Israelites written on stone tablets.
<b>Moses</b>	Baby boy taken in by a princess, the Pharaoh's daughter	<b>Idolatry</b>	Worshipping an idol.
<b>Exile</b>	Money or items that someone gives you when they die.	<b>Tabernacle</b>	A big tent built for the Israelites to worship wherever they went.
<b>Plagues</b>	Set of disasters that God sent to Egypt before the Israelites were freed.	<b>Kiddush</b>	The blessing said as darkness arrives.
<b>Passover</b>	The Angel of Death passed over the door when the Israelites ate their last meal.	<b>Haggadah</b>	The book containing the set of order of the Passover meal.
<b>Exodus</b>	The day that hundreds of men, woman and children walked out of Egypt.	<b>Hallel</b>	Jewish word meaning praise, the prayer sung to God for caring for the Israelites and rescuing them from slavery.
