- We change images for a number of reasons, it could be that you want to fix something that was in the original image, you want to change how someone feels about an image, you want to change the main topic of the photo to something else or you want to draw attention to a different part of the image
  - Images can be improved by rotating (turning), cropping (cutting the edges) using coloured filters and cloning (copying areas of a photo).
  - We can combine images to make new images.
  - I can look at images and decided if and how they have been edited.

<b>combine</b>	To join more than one image to make a new image.	<b>rotate</b>	To move in a circle.
<b>crop</b>	to cut off the sides of an image to make it the proper size or to remove unwanted parts.	<b>saturation</b>	The intensity of colour used in photos.
<b>edit</b>	making changes and reviewing	<b>undo</b>	To get rid of a change you have made.
