Key Knowledge

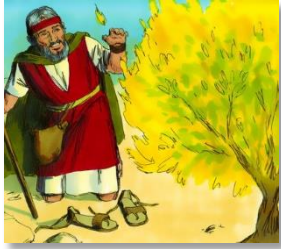
Joseph was given a coat of many colours by his father. His brothers were jealous of him and pretended he has been killed. Joseph had dreams that predicted to future.

Moses went to Egypt to free God's people but the Pharaoh did not listen-he had a hard heart. Passover, also called Pesach is a major Jewish holiday, one of the three pilgrimage festivals, that celebrates the Biblical story of the Israelites' escape
