We have been exploring our emotions this week with The Colour Monster. The children discussed when they have felt happy, sad, calm, angry, scared and loved and considered how they often feel lots of different emotions at the same time.

We listened to some different types of music and matched how they made us feel to an emotion, before drawing the things that make us feel happy.

The children have been proudly 'using their brains and eyes to subitise' in maths. They can now identify quantities of 1,2 and 3 without counting.

We have been blown away with the children's hardworking attitudes in phonics this week. We have started to blend sounds together to read words using our magnetic boards, and have been carefully practising our letter formation each morning.
